2017 AAST/AWS Annual Meeting Scholarship

The American Association for the Surgery of Trauma and the Association of Women Surgeons are offering an annual scholarship to subsidize one Medical Student, Resident or In-Training Fellow's attendance and participation in the 76th Annual Meeting of AAST and Clinical Congress of Acute Care Surgery. The meeting takes place in Baltimore, MD, September 13-16, 2017. Awardees are required to attend the entire meeting including but not limited to, all of the social events and the opening session. The award covers registration, four (4) nights hotel accommodations and a \$200 stipend for expenses.

Airfare is not included in the award and is the responsibility of the awardee.

The deadline to apply is June 1, 2017. Applicants will be notified by July 15, 2017 on the status of their application.

Requirements Include: a strong interest in trauma, must be a member of AWS, sponsorship and a letter of recommendation from an AAST or AWS member, and a CV. All applications must be completed by June 1, 2017 to be considered.
